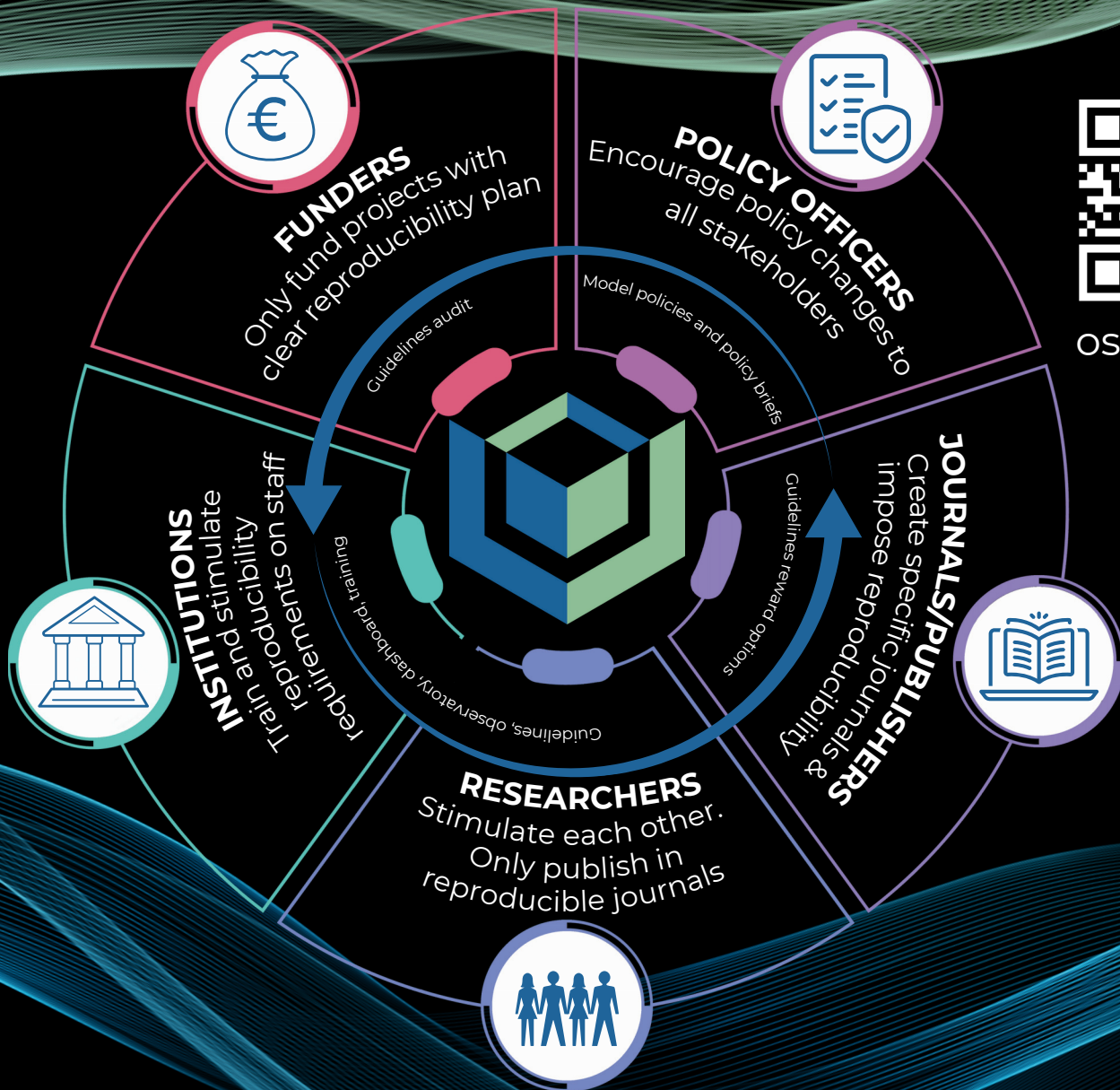

OSIRIS WP1

Coordination and Project Management

Work Package 1 will facilitate the smooth and timely implementation of the OSIRIS project work plan to achieve its objective. This WP1 will result in the development of the OSIRIS Project Handbook, including templates, procedures, meetings and planning of activities as well as a Data management plan.

OSIRIS WP2

Drivers, barriers and facilitators for reproducibility of research

Work Package 2 investigates the underlying drivers and effective interventions that increase reproducibility at funding, publishing, university and researcher-level; and compile and map evidence on reproducibility practice and what it means to different stakeholders, thus creating a strong knowledge base.



OSIRIS WP3

Interventions to improve reproducibility for researchers and institutions

Work Package 3 develops and tests effective, evidence-based interventions that increase transparency and reproducibility. After developing the interventions, it will test them empirically to demonstrate their usefulness.

OSIRIS WP4

Interventions to improve reproducibility for funders and journals

Work Package 4 will develop and evaluate automatic systems for compliance to reproducibility that can be used by publishers and/or funders. WP4 will also identify guidance and policies that can be implemented by funders.



OSIRIS WP5

Training and guidance to increase reproducibility

Work Package 5 will gather all the knowledge from the other work packages. Through a process of facilitated co-creation, design and user-testing, WP5 will develop effective and impactful resources that can be used to train researchers in how they can increase the reproducibility of their research.

OSIRIS WP6

Communication and Dissemination

Work Package 6 will highlight, showcase and ensure the evidence-based impact of OSIRIS throughout the duration of the project and beyond. It will produce a strategic Dissemination and Communication Plan, raise awareness of the objectives and achievements of OSIRIS through traditional and non-traditional means of communication as well as the project website, and map out, engage, and maintain a strong stakeholder network.
